- 10 Their handiwork shows, each wicked lewd plan; and every bribe, is in their right hand.
- 11 But as for me, I will walk right in You; ransom and save me, Your mercy hold true.
- 12 My feet now stand firm, in a place that is plain; with all those assembled, I'll bless the Lord's name.
